- ¼ cups Parmesan Cheese, Grated


FOR THE NACHOS:

- 1 cup Colby-Jack Cheese, Shredded



"Certified Self Contained Only Vehicles" is actually an illegal bylaw. Read this open letter to the Mayor of Whangarei. *By Jimi Hart*

Open Letter To Mayor Sheryl Mai.
Whangarei District Council
11th September 2016

CC. All current Mayors and Councillors. All Members of Parliament. All National Newspapers in New Zealand.

For your consideration

Dear Sheryl

I am writing this to inform everyone involved in tourism and freedom camping in NZ that there is a serious flaw in the new council rules applying to freedom campers. The Whangarei District Council has conceded it 'got it wrong' and has now done a total U-turn on their proposed freedom camping bylaw, stating it was a 'legal shambles'. They will now, make land available for the real freedom campers in this country.

This legal shambles has come about,

because this Council has taken too much advice from a private organisation, the New Zealand Motor Caravan Association, who have taken a self-appointed leading role with council's all around the country, shaping, advising, establishing and promoting an illegal bylaw. Certified Self Contained Freedom Camping Only.

Once upon a time, freedom campers all co-inhabited quite nicely. Motorhomes parked next to tents, young old, alternative, scruffy or stuffy. We were ALL just freedom campers. Doin' our thung! It was our right, as Kiwi's. As I was growing up, as a grubby teenager sprouting out in rural NZ, it was considered a rite of passage for a group of us to go out and sleep in a tent.

It was a right also, for any overseas visitors. People climbed the mountains, walked the trails and pitched tents and slept in vans and cars. An allowable pastime all could enjoy. A quintessential part of our culture everyone shared. It is something we have always done, for generations, since the earliest of settlers.

But now, it has boomed into a very large industry. Tourism. The largest single industry we have in NZ. We have done very well promoting our country as a clean, green, modern and multi-cultural society. Our country is viewed by the rest of the world as one big adventure park on a borderless landscape, full of outdoor pursuit's and always with stunning and breathtaking views.

In fact we have done so well at promoting it, we now find ourselves in quite a pickle. We are under-resourced, we have a major lack of infrastructure, but most importantly, we lack fair and honest leadership on how we ought to deal with it. Since 2011, Councils around the country in their panic to come up with solutions, have been coerced into bad decision making by this private organisation. We have allowed them, as expert advisers, to help create a new law, just for themselves. And that is the reason behind the legal shambles. That is where it has all gone pear-shaped. That, is the very reason common sense has not prevailed and that, is why we now find ourselves in this horrid predicament of not knowing how to deal with it.

Instead of naturally coming to the obvious conclusion of creating spaces and building new infrastructure as we went along, council's have been blindsided ... and we'll make it a law all around the country. If you don't have a toilet on board, you just can't go freedom camping anymore." Like Dad's Army setting off to fight a modern war.

And they almost did it. And we almost let them. In fact they did do it here in Whangarei, albeit briefly. They did it, in many other districts around the country too. Those who allowed them to cleverly

... But the fact remains. It is illegal and here's why;

THIS IS THE legal description of what it means to freedom camp. According to the Freedom Camping Act 2011 it means to camp in 1 or more of the following:

- A tent or other temporary structure
- A caravan.
- A car, campervan, housetruck, or other motor vehicle.


no-where, not even once, does the FCA mention certified self containment. To have this important 'fix-it-all' term left-out entirely from this document, says a great deal.

You see, if we alter and re-label what it is to freedom camp, especially when it enables one group more privilege than others. If we take it off the poor and give it to the rich, or if you like, we take it off youth on a shoe-string budget and allow it as only a rite of passage for those who can afford a CSC vehicle, it breaches another act, our rights (abridged).
